Agenda

- Review IBC applications.
 - Lab Simply
 - Phil reviewed the project description including purpose of work and experimental design. It was as described in the application.
 - Yolanda Fintschenko made a motion to approve the application without changes. George Farquar seconded the motion. The application was opened for discussion.
 - Julia asked about the method of solid waste disposal. Phil answered that he is contracting with Clean Harbor. His account has been created. Janelle asked about liquid waste. His liquid waste will be bleached per standard operating procedures and discarded in the sink. Any chemical waste will be disposed of by Clean Harbor.

 - George Farquar asked about using BSL1 or BSL2 protocols with BT. Phil answered that he erred on the side of caution and uses BSL2 protocols with BT.

 - Meryem asked about vaccination requirements for Staph A and Strep Pneumoniae. Julia, our expert in these matters, noted it is not required.
 - Yolanda asked about extra signage requirements beyond existing signage, which lists the risk group 2 organisms being used in the lab. Julia replied best practice is to label the secondary storage containers with the risk group and the organism. This practice is already included in the Daybreak Labs SOP for BSL2, so the committee agreed there is no need to revise the application.

- Janelle asked about section A.8.2. if the 10%bleach wipe down would be followed with water to protect the stainless steel surface. Phil answered that this was their SOP. The committee agreed this does not need to be added to agreement as this is good laboratory practice and standard laboratory practice.
- The sonicator use in the hood was noted and question was asked regarding the level of noise. The level of noise will be minimal, and standard hearing protection will be used. This is covered in the agreement, so no change is required.

- The discussion was closed and the motion was voted on. The motion passed unanimously.
